

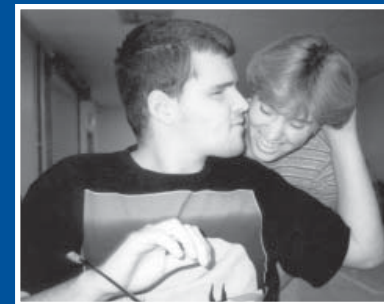
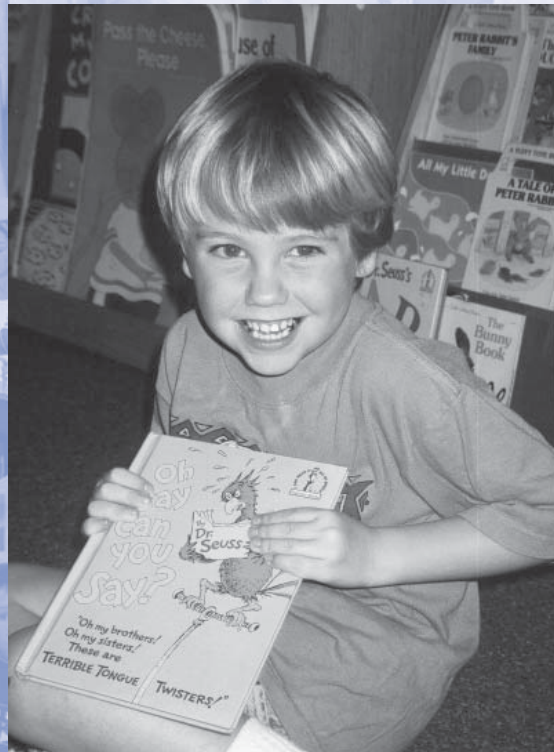


Who are we?

The Florida State Legislature allocates funds that are administered to the six regional CARD sites through the state's Department of Education. 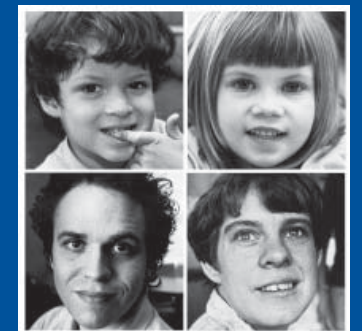
